

CONDITIONS FOR USE OF KEBS STANDARDISATION MARK

1. This permit is issued subject to the provisions of the Standards Act, Cap 496 Laws of Kenya and Standardization Marks (Permits and Fees) Regulations, which includes;
 - a) The permit-holder shall comply with the general and specific conditions and scheme of supervision and control which the Kenya Bureau of Standards may issue from time to time.
 - b) The permit is not transferable.
 - c) Cost incurred by inspection to determine whether commodities to which the Standardization Mark has been applied fulfil the applicable requirements set forth by the Kenya Bureau of Standards shall be borne by the permit holder to the extent specified in the scheme of supervision and control of commodities listed in the permit.
 - d) The right to use of the mark applies only to the commodities listed in the permit.
 - e) Costs incurred in applying the Standardization Mark shall be borne by the permit- holder.
 - f) The Bureau reserves the right to revise the regulations for marking standardised commodities.
 - g) If the Kenyan Standard or approved specification on which the permit is based is revised, the permit shall be valid only if the permit-holder agrees to comply with the requirements set out in the revised Kenya Standard or approved specifications.
 - h) The permit is valid for the period shown unless otherwise suspended or revoked.
2. The breach of any of the conditions contained in this permit constitutes an offence under the provisions of the Standards Act and the Standardization Marks (Permits and Fees) Regulations.
